

Euro-Centrum Science and Technology Park, Limited Liability Company further to the procurement procedure number Z-21/VI/2011/PNT for:

**“Supply of In-House (Indoor) Solar Collectors and Systems Testing Laboratory for the Solar Systems Test Centre”**

with relation to the Project entitled "Foundation of Euro-Centrum Science and Technology Park - Development and Application of New Technologies in the Field of Energy Conservation and Renewables";

implemented within the framework of Priority Axis 5: Diffusion of Innovation;

Measure 5.3: Support for Innovation Centres of the Innovative Economy Operational Programme;

Co-financed with the European Union funds and the State Budget;

with regard to the Financial Support Agreement dated 8<sup>th</sup> October 2010, number POIG.05.03.00-00-010/10-00 [POIG - Innovative Economy Operational Programme].

we kindly inform that on 1st July 2011 we received queries and comments to the above referred procurement procedure related documentation, which we address below:

- 1) The call is entitled "...Solar Collectors and Systems Testing Laboratory ". However, all technical requirements related to the test facility etc. are limited to collectors only. Do you intend to issue an additional call related to testing equipment for solar thermal systems?

The Contracting Authority explains that the in-house laboratory should meet the requirements for solar collector testing purposes in compliance with EN 12975:2006 standard. The laboratory shall also provide for additional efficiency tests of small-sized solar systems, therefore, the title of the procurement procedure includes this wording: "... and solar systems". The above does not, however, necessitate the supplier's compliance with additional technical requirements besides EN 12975 standard.

- 2) In the doc entitled Specification of essential terms of the contract" in chapter 2.2 on page 2 the amount of 193.000 EUR is mentioned.

The Contracting Authority explains that the amount mentioned in the Specification of Essential Terms of the Contract is the assessment threshold for the value of the object of the procurement procedure. If the value exceeds the said threshold, the Contracting Authority must apply the stricter contract award procurement procedure, in compliance with its Procurement Procedure Regulations. The above amount does not constitute a limitation on the Contractor's remuneration which may exceed 193 000 EURO.
